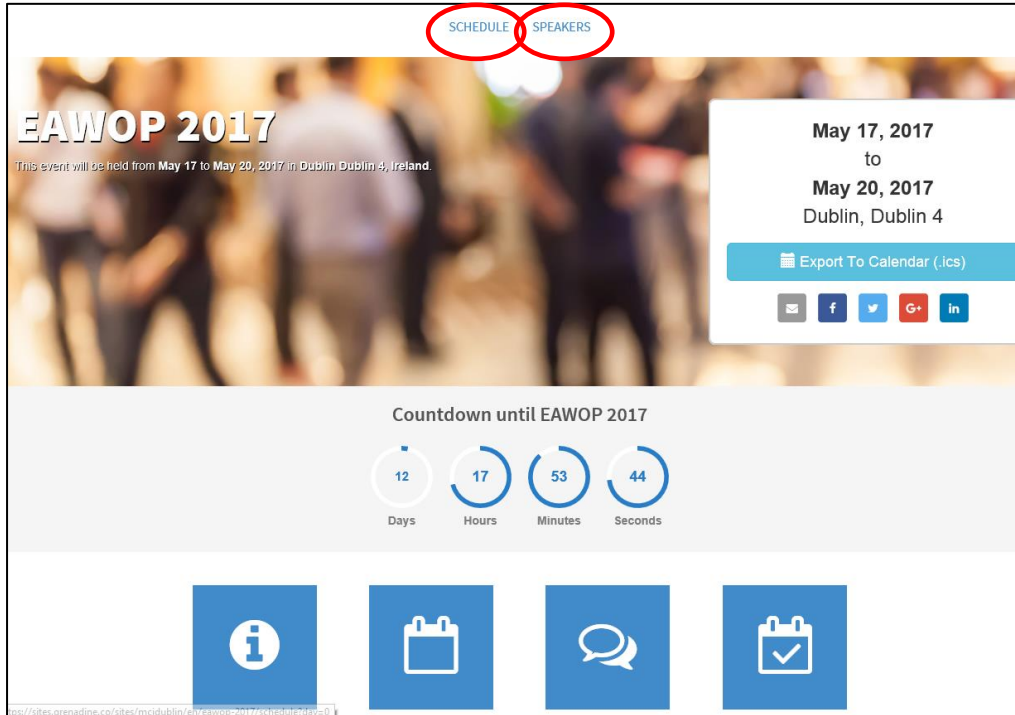


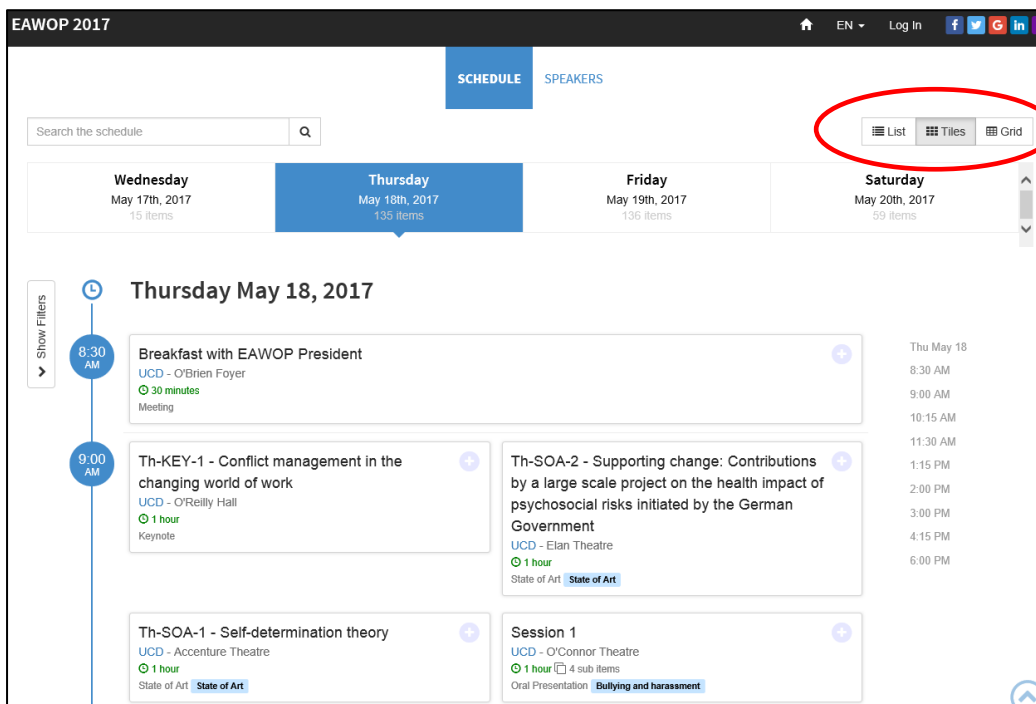
How to use the congress program

The congress program is fully interactive so there are a number of ways you can view and search for information.

You can view the program in a schedule format, or by searching for speakers by using the 2 options at the top of the page.



If you are viewing the program in schedule format there are 3 views you can choose between: List, Tiles or Grid. These options are at the top right of the page.



You can also search the schedule by keyword, or you can filter by room, type of presentation or topic. These options are at the top left of the page.
